



International Whitsun Tournament V.V. Kamerik

Terms & Conditions

The International Whitsun Tournament is an initiative of the junior department of football club V.V. Kamerik, established in Kamerik, The Netherlands. Hereinafter referred to as: the organization. The International Whitsun Tournament takes place at the site of V.V. Kamerik.

Registering a team

Registration for the International Whitsun Tournament can be done in 2 ways:

- Via the form on the website: www.vvkamerik.nl
- Via the registration form that you have received from the organization.

To register as a contact person you need to send us some contact details. This information should be correct and complete. These data will be used by the organization to inform you about the International Whitsun Tournament. A confirmation of your preliminary registration will follow as soon as possible after the organization has received your registration form. A preliminary registration is only definitive after the down payment is in the bank account of the organization.

The organization reserves the right, without giving any reason, to refuse an application for participation. In case of refusal of a team, the club will be informed about this as soon as possible. The organization will pay back the down payment to the account from which the down payment was paid.

Entering the team members

The contact person has to inform the organization about names and birth dates of the players on his team. These personal data will only be used by the organization for the International Whitsun Tournament. If a player is under the age of 18, he or she must have consent from his or her legal representatives before this player may enter. If you enter a player under the age of 18, the organization will assume that this consent has been taken care of by you. A team consists of at least 15 players and 2 coaches/supervisors (other than players). Coaches/supervisors must be at least 18 years old. All players must be member of the football association in their country.

Payment Terms

The down payment is 450 Euro for a team including coaches/supervisors. The down payment must be in the bank account of the organization on the date specified in the confirmation letter of the preliminary registration. When the down payment is not in the bank account of the organization on the agreed date, the preliminary registration automatically expires.

The remainder of the total amount must be in the bank account of the organization on the date specified in the confirmation letter of the preliminary registration. It is not allowed to pay the remainder of the total amount in cash upon arrival at the tournament.



If a club cancels after payment of the total amount owed, then the amount paid is not automatically refunded. If the organization succeeds in finding a team from another club to pay the full registration fee, the organization may decide to repay (a part of) the amount paid to the team which is cancelling. For getting a possible refund the cancelling team must inform the organization in writing with the reason for not participating. The organization may at any time decide not to refund regardless of the reasons of cancelling.

The total amount due is based on the registration fee per person multiplied by the specified number of players plus coaches. If you end up with more players plus coaches than previously entered, you can use the possibility of paying the costs for the extra persons at our premises in cash to the organization before the tournament starts.

For any player or coach the full entry fee always has to be paid, even if they arrive later or leave earlier. If a player or coach is replaced by another player or coach during the tournament, no fee will be charged for the substitute player or coach. This applies only if the replaced player or coach leaves, thus no longer participates in the activities on the premises of the organization during the tournament weekend.

General Affairs

It is important that all players have fun and respect each other. Therefore, there are certain rules which all players and coaches should adhere to during the match days. These rules are listed in the program and will be discussed with the supervisors of the respective teams before the start of the tournament.

Responsibilities supervisors

As a supervisor, you have to respect all rules and instructions that the organization has made. In addition to that you have to inform all players about the "game rules" in advance. As a supervisor you set an example for your team and you are responsible for the behaviour of your team during the whole tournament. If one of the team members doesn't fulfil the commitments, the organization will contact the supervisor of the team. The supervisor must take his/her responsibility and take action to this team member! If team members, after repeated warnings, do not behave properly, the organization retains the right to remove the participant(s) from the tournament.

As a supervisor you must ensure that:

- all team members are present at times established by the organization at which matches or other activities begin.
- all team members use proper footwear that is suitable for different surfaces.
- all team members behave in a decent manner throughout the entire tournament.
- all team members can show a valid ID on request to the organization before the start of the tournament.
- all team members use moderation while drinking alcoholic beverages.
- the team members do not have and/or use drugs on the premises of the organization.



Liability and safeguards

The participating teams recognize that participation at the International Whitsun Tournament V.V Kamerik is at their own risk. To the extent legally possible, the organization is not liable for any damages, direct or indirect, arising from or in any way connected with the International Whitsun Tournament, also including but not limited to, any damage caused by, or in any way related to:

- The participation of a person to the International Whitsun Tournament;
- Modification, suspending or termination of the International Whitsun Tournament and/or changing the prize if circumstances so require;
- Any additional costs that you may need to make participation in the International Whitsun Tournament.

Prizes

The participating teams can win various prizes. The prizes can be won by teams and individuals. All prizes are linked to a team or person and therefore not transferable and not redeemable for cash. If a prize is refused by a team or individual or if there is any reason a prize is not awarded, the prize will go to the organization.

Copyright and cooperation

Participants in the tournament are aware that it is possible that pictures and/or film recordings will be made during the tournament and activities around it. By participating, you allow the organization to use these pictures/film recordings for expressions related to the International Whitsun Tournament (e.g. the website or in PR material).

Rights organization

The organization reserves the right at all times to end the participation of a team in the tournament if one or more team members in any way act contrary to these conditions, the 'rules' or any statutory provision applicable, without prior notice, without giving any reason, at its discretion. The organization cannot be held liable for any consequences of these disciplinary actions.

The organization also reserves the right to terminate, suspend or modify and/or change prizes at the tournament without prior notice when circumstances so require.

We will then establish a new provision to replace the void/destroyed one. As far as possible the scope of the void/nullified provision will be taken. These conditions are subject to Dutch law. Any disputes arising there from or otherwise related to the International Whitsun Tournament will be submitted to a competent court.
